The first annual Measure Z report to the community by the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) is for information only.

BACKGROUND

The voters of the Portola Valley School District approved the Measure Z School Facilities Bond on November 8, 2018. This is a Prop 39 bond and, as such, Ed. Code requires that a Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) be established. The seven-person committee was established by the Board on April 17, 2019. The membership changed on September 11, 2019 when committee member Anne Fazioli-Khiari filled the vacant Governing Board seat in December. Amanda Smoot assumed Ms. Fazioli-Khiari's seat on the CBOC.

The term of office is two years, with a three-term limit. In order to stagger term limits, two members will begin with a one year initial term.

The CBOC has met three times thus far. CBOC meetings are governed by the Brown Act, and are open to the public. The CBOC provides oversight and advises the public as to whether or not the District is spending the Measure Z bond funds in a manner consistent with the Bond Project List. The CBOC is required by State law to review the program and issue a report to the public annually on the proper expenditures of taxpayers' money.

Attached is the annual report for 2018-19. The CBOC Chairperson, Gary Hanning, and Vice-Chair, Nelly Wolfson will present and comment on this report.
